

Conservation & Community

It's about protecting nature and the community. This is your chance to contribute to conservation, make a difference and get back to nature while engaging with the local community.

Project summary:

Volunteers are employed from Monday to Friday, and the average working day is 8 hours. The weekends are at the volunteers' free disposal, either to relax at home or to go on excursions.

Exciting and interesting things happen frequently in the game reserve, and this dynamic is incorporated into the program as much as possible. Volunteers are provided with a qualified game warden as a supervisor and a Land Rover for their sole use for the duration of the program.



Requirements:

- Minimum age: 18 years (younger on request).
- A positive attitude towards the environment
- Interested in conservation, Africa and its inhabitants
- Not afraid of dealing with vulnerable children and people affected by HIV/AIDS
- Caring towards oneself and one's fellow human beings
- Language skills: Basic knowledge sufficient
- Minimum duration: 2 weeks

Included:

- Transfer from/to the airport on Monday
- 3 meals daily
- Accommodation (one-story renovated old railway house with 7 bedrooms)
- Laundry service
- packed lunch / thermos bottles
- Bush camping kitchen equipment
