#### Information

1) Comprehensive insurance is mandatory in Australia! The Australian authorities take out an health insurance policy for each student, which covers a large part of the costs. Optionally, we offer an insurance package from IMG. The package includes health-, accident- und liability insurance (from CHF 90.-/month). For further information please contact us

2) Program fees include: complete personal consultation, preparation meeting, communication with the responsible ministry of education, 24/7 emergency service (LGA staff - no call center), assistance with flight bookings and visa application, and constant contact for all other matters.

3) These are the estimated total costs. They are based on experience and depend on any adjustments made by the partner, schools/school districts, insurance companies or unexpected currency fluctuations. Not included are personal expenses on site (e.g. pocket money, school uniform, transport costs, cost for applying for a student visa, etc.).

4) Authority fees include school tuition, host family selection and screening, airport pick-up, placement and administration fees, local support, and Government-mandated health insurance. Please note that these fees change annually and are usually reset by the Australian authorities in the last quarter of the year.
