#### **Information**

1) Canadian government fees include tuition fees, placement in a certified host family, airport pickup, on-site care and government-mandated health insurance. Please note that the fees are subject to change and are usually not reset by the Canadian authorities until the last quarter of the year. Important - School fees for placements in large cities are significantly higher.

2) The program fees include: complete personal consultation, preparation meetings, communication with school districts in Canada, 24/7 emergency service (LGA staff - no call center), assistance with flight bookings and visa application, and constant contact for all other matters

3) These are the estimated total costs. They are based on experience and are subject to possible adjustments by the partner, the schools/school districts, insurance companies or unexpected currency fluctuations. Not included are personal expenses on site (e.g. pocket money, school uniform, transport costs, etc.).
