### Information

1) Normally, Swiss health insurance is accepted in Costa Rica (confirmation in Spanish). Optionally, we offer an insurance package from IMG. The package includes health-, accident- and liability insurance (from CHF 90.-/month). Please contact us for further information!

2) Program fees include: complete personal consultation, preparation meeting, placement at a school and with a certified host family, airport pickup, on-site assistance, language course (20 lessons à 45 minutes - online course), 24/7 emergency service (LGA staff - no call center), assistance with flight bookings and, if applicable, visa application, and constant contact for all other matters.

3) These are the estimated total costs. They are based on experience and depend on any adjustments made by the partner, schools/school districts, insurance companies or unexpected currency fluctuations. Not included are personal expenses on site (e.g. pocket money, school uniform, transport costs, etc.).

### Visa

Upon entry, a tourist visa for the first 3 months is obtained, which is then converted into a student visa on site during the stay by means of extensive documents from Switzerland (translated, certified and partly provided with an apostille). Here the participants will receive detailed information from us via mail or post.
